Admissions Status

Students may be admitted to the BAS, Hospitality program under one of the following:

- 1. **Provisional Admission:** Students who are within 25 quarter credits of completing their two-year degree may be admitted provisionally into the program if space is available.
- 2. **Probationary Admission:** Students with a GPA below 2.5 may be admitted on a probationary status. Students must maintain a GPA of 2.0 or higher for the first 30 quarter credits and then petition to the BAS committee for full admittance.
- 3. *Full Admission:* Students will be fully admitted to the program when all admission requirements have been completed and accepted by the BAS Committee.
- 4. **Non-matriculated students:** Students may take up 15 HMG programs credits with prior faculty approval. Once admitted to the program, those classes will be applied towards the individual's degree.
