- Minimum passing grade of 1.0 is required in all courses.
- At least 15 credits must be earned at the degree-granting college.
- Students should apply for the degree one quarter prior to anticipated graduation date.
- Completion of degree does not guarantee admission to a university/major program, nor that all general education requirements are met
