

South Seattle College- Aviation Seminar Program-Steps to Enroll 2023

The following steps are intended for students enrolling in the Aviation Airframe & Powerplant Seminar (For Transitioning Military personnel & Veterans) at South Seattle College. Our program page can be found [HERE](#).

All students must first apply and be accepted through the SkillBridge program at <https://skillbridge.osd.mil/>. All interested students should review information through the Aviation Pathways Program Orientation at <https://pacmtn.org/aviation-pathways/#/>. Once you have been approved for the program, please follow the below steps-to-enroll below for South Seattle college.

1. Submit Your Admissions Application

- Complete our [South Seattle College Admissions Application](#). Follow directions listed on the website.
- For this Aviation Airframe and Powerplant Seminar, please create an account and use the below information to start your application.

- Once you have submitted your application, please send an email to South's Registration department with your application number using the below email template. If you are an out-of-state resident stationed at JBLM, please attach copies your state issued photo ID (not your military ID) and your station orders. This will help ensure that you receive in-state tuition rate for this seminar.

(Please make sure to check all email folders including promotional and junk mailboxes for this email).
- Keep this unique number safe as you will use it throughout your time at South Seattle College.

2. **Check in about Funding**

There are multiple options for funding for the Aviation Seminar. You should first apply to use Workforce funding or WIOA funds. If you're ineligible for those, then you can use your GI Bill; however, we try to use the other sources first so we don't use up time on your GI Bill.

1st Priority Option-Workforce: To utilize Workforce funding, please contact them at: workforcesouth@seattlecolleges.edu and complete this intake survey at [Workforce Intake](#). You'll need to include either/or: DD 214, separation papers, ETS orders, or an acceptance letter from Thurston County Chamber into the Aviation Seminar program to the Workforce team.

2nd Priority Option-WIOA: This is a specialized funding source for Thurston County Residents. Please check in with Aviation Pathways at if you are eligible for this specialized funding.

3rd (Last Option)-GI Bill: If you plan on using your GI bill, please contact Megan Goosetree in our Financial Aid department at Megan.Goosetree@Seattlecolleges.edu and let her know that you are attending the JBLM Aviation Seminar and are wanting to use the GI Bill. We try to encourage folks to utilize other funding source before using their GI Bill as a way to save your GI Bill for yourself and/or your family.

Regardless of what funding source, we will make sure to put a hold on your account once funding is established, so you are not dropped from the class for non-payment.

3. **Activate your CTC Account/Tech Access**

Once your application has been processed, you will be provided a ctcLinkID . You will use your ctcLink ID number to activate your ctcLink Account. (You will only need to activate it once).

1. Go to the ctcLink [Gateway page](#).
2. Select "Activate Your Account".
3. Use your first name, last name, date of birth, and ctcLink ID number to activate your account.

If needed, [Watch this video to go over the ctcLink account activation process](#). Your ctcLink Account will be used for a variety of processes. Your ctcLink account stores information about your student accounts, financial balances, class registration, enrollment, and transcripts.

4. **Register for Classes**

-If you've already emailed Registration (See step 1 for the email template) there is no further action needed to self-register as Registration should be registering you for the JBLM Aviation Seminar classes. Check your email for confirmation from Registration about registering you. For questions or to clarify with Registration send them an email: sscregistration@seattlecolleges.edu

(Only applicable if you are not registered for classes w/ Registration-Once you activate your account, you should be able to self-register for the two Aviation seminar classes, **AMT 295 and AMT 296**. You will start by

going to the student tab on the South home page at <https://southseattle.edu/students> and going to class schedule. Here is the [Guide to Register in ctcLink](#) for screen shot directions.

Please note that while registering, the permission number box shows up for everyone. You should not need a permission code to register. Leave this field blank and click "Save".)
