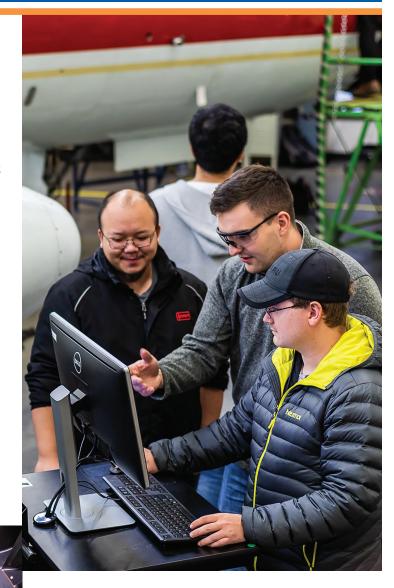
Program Overview

South's Aeronautical Technology program is one of the largest, most experienced FAA-approved programs in Washington state. Students learn how to keep aircraft in peak operating condition by performing hands-on maintenance, repairs and inspections.

Classes are taught by seasoned aviation professionals on real engines and airplanes on our main campus, and in our hangar at King County International Airport (Boeing Field). After completing the two-year program, students are certified to take their FAA-licensing exams.

Program Details

- · Associate degree and certificate program options
- Short-term certificates also available for transitioning service members and veterans
- Average length of certificate and associate degree (AAS) program is two years
- Average tuition cost (full-time, in-state) is \$2,000 per quarter (includes tuition, textbooks, fees & tools)
- Enrolls new students in Spring & Fall Quarters
