Role and Responsibilities

The Hourly Assistant will be required to perform duties as assigned and directed by the Supervisory Lab Technician of Biology. Those duties will include staffing of Open Labs, which entails providing models and slides for the students to study outside of regular lab time. It may include simple lab model set-up and breakdown. Must be able to lift 50 pounds. Only two models are that heavy. The rest are much lighter.

Essential Functions:

Help set up and break down Anatomy & Physiology labs.
