Role and Responsibilities

- floor mopping,
- some clay recycling, sink scrap management,
- Maintain classroom by:
 - Organize left over clay (throw dried clay in reclaim, wet bagged clay in gray bin, semi dried clay add water in bag)
 - Wipe down tables
 - Wash any tools borrowed
 - Clean wheels (Unplug the power strips and all the wheels first)
 - Collect, wash and clean any borrowed ware-boards and bats outside
 - Wash and wipe the glaze buckets
 - Keep wedging tables wiped down
 - Organizing and keeping extruders cleaned
- Oversee classroom during Open Lab and club hours:
 - Oversee general ceramics safety guidelines
 - Ensure that students follow general ceramics safety guidelines
