We the People Civic Engagement-October 7-9

VP/Voter Educator Hussen Nurhussen organized several civic engagement programs for students, including speakers Larry Cushnie, political science instructor, and the Washington Bus. Topics included what will be on the November ballot and why students should care. There was also voter registration training.

Coffee and Donuts: USA Open House-October 16
