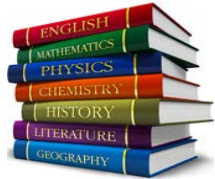

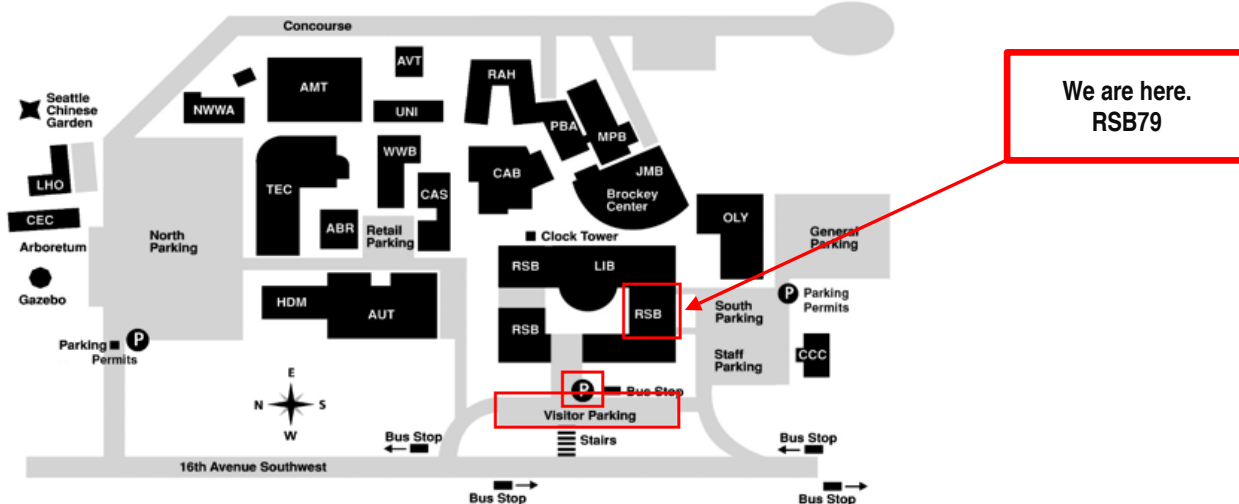


WORKFORCE EDUCATION WORKSHOPS
