How do I get a tutor?

Simple! Fill out the Tutor Request Form on the back of this brochure, have your instructor sign it, and return it to the staff in room RSB 12. The Tutoring Center will provide your contact information to an appropriate tutor. Then the tutor will contact you to arrange a meeting.

How often and for how long will I meet with my tutor?

You will meet with your tutor from 1 to 3 hours per week. You and your tutor can decide how to distribute those hours.
