***TARGET AND REFINE A RESUME** - A resume is one of the first chances you have to impress a potential employer and a necessity in your job search. During the Resume workshop, you will have support in developing a strong resume tailored to the position you're applying to. Get assistance with formatting, content, proofreading and more. Please bring your resume and a job description for the position you are interested in.

***ENVISIONING YOUR IDEAL CAREER** - Learn the value of the career exploration process and how this can positively impact your future. Develop the skills and be introduced to the long-term value of career exploration and planning, identify factors influencing your career choice(s), and employ career exploration resources to develop specific next steps in your career exploration process.

***YOUR ONLINE JOB SEARCH** - This workshop emphasizes the importance of using key words and industry specific terminology to identify employers, job openings and opportunities on the internet. Be prepared to use all the information on web sites to focus a successful job search strategy.

***RESUME WRITING AND COVER LETTERS** - How to use online resources and job postings to customize job search documents for individual jobs and industries. By creating targeted resumes and correspondence employers will know your skills, competencies, training and experiences meet their needs.

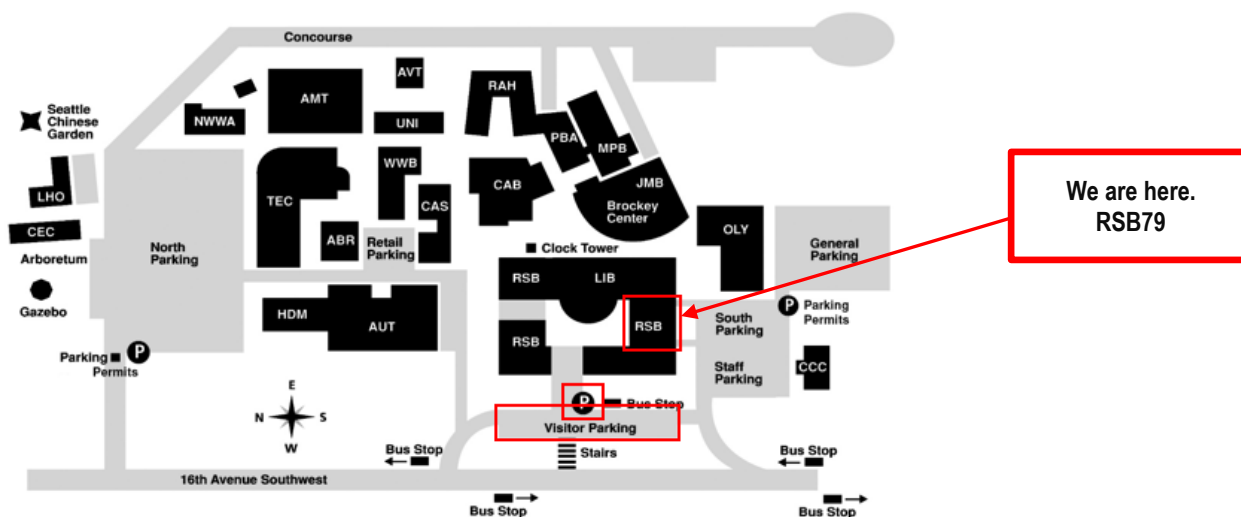
INTERNSHIP SEARCH - This workshop will provide information on the internship process. Topics will include: what is an internship and its benefits, who is eligible for one and which programs require one or how to receive credit for one if it is not required, and searching, applying and obtaining an internship.

CAREER SPECIALIST WALK-IN HOURS - Come meet with an Embedded Career Specialist (ECS) to get help with your resume and, for students, discuss internship options. Internships can be paid and used to gain academic credits, while furthering your experience in the field.
