<ul> <li>Creating a SecureAccess Washington account</li> <li>1. Go to SecureAccess Washington and select Create an Account.</li> <li>2. Click Start.</li> <li>3. Enter your personal information in the fields provided and click Next.</li> <li>4. Create a user ID and password and click Next.</li> <li>5. Review your information (You may want to print this page for your records). Click Next.</li> <li>6. Enter the security code in the field provided and click Submit.</li> <li>7. You'll see an on-screen request to check your email for a message from SecureAccess Washington.</li> <li>8. Go to your email inbox, open the message and click the link to activate your new account. This link takes you back to SecureAccess Washington.</li> <li>9. Enter the User ID and Password you created in Step 4 above and click Login.</li> </ul>
